Scholarships to assist female Nevada college students to attend the 2020 National Conference of College Women Student Leaders (NCCWSL), MAY 27–30, 2020, at the University of Maryland, College Park, Maryland.

### **Scholarship Requirements:**

- **Must be:**
  - A Nevada resident or enrolled in a Nevada college/university
  - A currently enrolled freshman, sophomore, or junior female student with a minimum 3.0 GPA
- **Must submit**
  - An application and essay\* to be returned by March 24, 2020 to:

  - A recommendation from a college/university official or faculty
  - A list of college and current community activities noting leadership roles you have held.

### **Post-Conference requirements:**

- Must agree to present NCCWSL & AAUW information to other college women (e.g., clubs, sororities, classes, etc.)
- Participate in a video interview that will be made available to AAUW Nevada branches.

**\*Essay:** One page, typed, double-spaced, 400-500 words

- Section A. Describe a leader who has inspired you to become one
- Section B. Describe the qualities that you have that will assist you in becoming a leader.
- Section C. Describe how you plan to utilize this leadership experience in future activities.
